We have arriving later this month Chateau Teyssier 2018, from this outstanding vintage. 93/100 James Sucking.

Last few cases left in bottles of the **Chateau Teyssier St Emilion 2016** 91/100 Robert Parker only £12.50 per bottle, magnums still available, probably the best value wine on the right bank, the 2015 vintage is also available in magnums. The excellent **Pauillac 2017** (from a rather famous Grand Cru Classe estate) in bottles from this drinking vintage, soft tannins, delicious and ready to drink.

We have collected from Bordeaux our allocation of the **Pauillac 2018**. We tasted the wine during our visit to Bordeaux in October last year, the wine is excellent, tasting notes enclosed, we were also able to secure a few cases in magnums. Our mystery wine from a classified estate.

New arrival from Bordeaux **Chateau La Fleur Bellevue 2018** (right bank wine) Gold medal winner £9.00 per bottle, Chateau Cayla 2016 makes a welcome return, remaining cases from the chateau purchased.

Claret of the month: **Chateau Ramafort 2010 Cru Bourgeois**, only releases their wine when ready to be consumed, previous owners Chateau Lafite Rothschild, only £16.50 per bottle. Full details below. Outstanding wine.

Shipped directly from their cellars, **Hautes du Tertre 2012** (second wine Chateau du Tertre) Margaux in bottles & magnums, has been purchased, mature claret with an excellent rating. Outstanding mature claret.

From the region of Lustrac Medoc which makes consistent good wines each year comes **Chateau Fonreud 2015 Cru Bourgeois rated 92/100** Wine Advocate.

The outstanding **Chateau Beaumont 2015 Cru Bourgeois** from the chateau in bottles, tasted and recommended, scored an amazing 90/100 Wine Advocate & 91/100 Neil Martin. Delicious.

The Graves region always shows up some special wines, the Chateau Les Clauzots 2016 Graves, purchased, is a buy 90/100 Vinous

La Colina Sauvignon Blanc 2020 £16.50 per bottle

Tasting Notes: Pale yellow, brilliant white wine with intense aromas and full and unctuous on the palate. Slightly glycerous with just the right acidic bite and pleasantly long lasting. Gastronomy: Perfect with grilled or baked fish, a good match for more complex rice dishes with fish serving.

Joseph Drouhin's white Rully Burgundy 2020 at £20.50 per bottle outstanding quality, small yields, classy wine.

Janisson Baradon, established in 1922, produces fine quality Champagnes. Janisson Baradon is a fifth generation of family business based in Epernay. Its champagnes are produced using grapes grown from its own vineyards, which span 22 acres.

The grapes come from three champagne vines in different terrains, which give the champagnes their distinctive taste. The emphasis is very much on quality and this is reflected in the number of awards that they have won in France.

Expressive wine that makes a good introduction to the house style. Clean veins of minerality support the fruit in this mid-weight, attractive wine. Pears, flowers are nicely layered into the finish. Superb value.

Clouet family is a family of winemakers whose origins, as they say, "got lost in the mists of time". Its founder was a printer in the Versailles court of Louis XV and for several generations, their descendants continued this work. This peculiar style "Ancien Regime" on their labels is a tribute to the founder of the house. It took more than two centuries and several generations of Clouet to get plots of vines in the terroir of Bouzy, which remain in the hands of the family of its founder. Bouzy is situated in the southern part of the Mountain of Reims.

The rose Champagne has lively, pink bubbles. Excellent deep colour and a beautiful nose filled with strawberry, raspberry and almonds. On the palate the champagne is creamy and fruity, excellent with both food and as an aperitif on that special night. Outstanding rose!! 92/100 Stephen Tanzer.

 Pol Roger's just-released 2013 Brut Vintage is a beautifully chiselled, incisive wine that will appeal immensely to purists. Unwinding in the glass with scents of citrus zest, white flowers, crushed chalk and hints of fresh sourdoughs, it's medium to full-bodied, racy and precise, with a nicely concentrated and tightly wound core, tangy acids and an elegant pinpoint mousse. After the rich, muscular 2012 vintage, the 2013 represents quite a contrast; I'm not sure we'll see its stylistic like again for some time, so readers with classically inclined palates will want to stock up—advice I'll be following myself. 94/100 RP

 Pol Roger's newly released 2012 Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill is showing brilliantly, bursting from the glass with youthful aromas of honeyed pears, toasted brioche, pomelo, fresh pastry, green apple and mandarin orange, with hints of stone fruit emerging with time in the glass. Full-bodied, vinous and textural, with an enveloping core of fleshy, concentrated fruit, bright acids and an elegant pinpoint mousse, it concludes with a long, penetrating finish. More muscular and vibrant than the generous and charming 2009, the 2012 ranks alongside the 2008 and 2002 as one of the three finest renditions of Sir Winston Churchill this millennium—and in style it resembles a hypothetical blend of those two vintages. 96+/100 RP

 With its rich Merlot and structured Cabernet Sauvignon, this wine is open, rich with generous tannins. Black-plum flavours give ripeness to the spicy, full-bodied wine that has good potential.
 This wine comes from the oldest wine region in Bordeaux, just across the river from famous estates on the Left Bank. Overlooking the Gironde Estuary, this amphitheatre of vines forms the La Rose Bellevue vineyard. It is located on the highest point of Saint Palais and its protected rows of vines are grown in mixed soils of fine gravel, sand, and silt. The wine is a very elegant blend of 75% Merlot and 25% Cabernet Sauvignon. The palate is lush with flavours of black currant and black cherry.

(This Chateau is situated next door to Chateau Beychevelle St Julien) Silver Medal award. 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 50% Merlot Chateau du Raux produces a wine typical of the Médoc—deep in colour, full bodied, seamlessly structured and built for aging. The nose is subtly spicy leading to a round, structured yet elegant palate with bright aromas of fresh berries and hints of cedar and cocoa.

The 2016 Chateau de Cerons presents notable density and power in its dark, cherry, plum, chocolate, liquorice and leather notes. This plush Graves has come together nicely during elevage. 90/100 Neil Martin

The 2015 Beaumont feels quite sophisticated on the nose with wild strawberry and subtle pressed flower scents. The palate is medium-bodied with firm grip and fine tannin, plus plenty of classic tobacco-infused fruit on the finish. This is a superb wine from Beaumont. 91/100 Neil Martin. Delicious. 90/100 Robert Parker

20 cases Chateau Ramafort 2010 £198.00 per case 12/1 £16.50 per bottle inc vat.

This excellent Cru Bourgeois Chateau, formerly owned by Chateau Lafite Rothschild, only releases the wines from its fairy-tale 17th century cellars, the largest in the Medoc (known locally as the Cathedral), when they judge the wines are perfect for drinking.

"A corking Cru Bourgeois Medoc from a 10/10 vintage". - Jonathan Ray, The Spectator

The 2010 is perfect for drinking now and will be for the next 5 years, coming direct from their cellars

A blend of 50% merlot and 50% cabernet sauvignon. Dense deep red colour in the glass. The nose is full of smooth and rich red berries and black fruit - cherry, blueberry and blackberries. The palette is wonderful with a full-body and weight to it, while incorporating gorgeous softened tannins after time in bottle. The style is clean with structure and a classic Medoc feel to it. There are very subtle chocolate and toasty toffee notes from the oak along with a gorgeous lengthy finish. Allow 20-30 minutes in a decanter before drinking.

25 cases Chateau Fonreud 2015 Lustrac £203.40 per case 12/1 £16.95 per bottle inc vat

Tasted at the Cru Bourgeois annual tasting, the 2015 Fonreud offers impressive, engaging blackberry and briary scents on the nose, well defined and focused with just a slight reduction that works in its favour. The palate is medium-bodied with firm fine tannin, plenty of spice-tinged black fruit mixed with graphite and cedar toward the structured finish. I admire the length of this Lustrac and I suspect it will give many years of pleasure. Sign me up!! Tasted September 2017 **92/100 Wine Advocate**.
